### Junior Suite



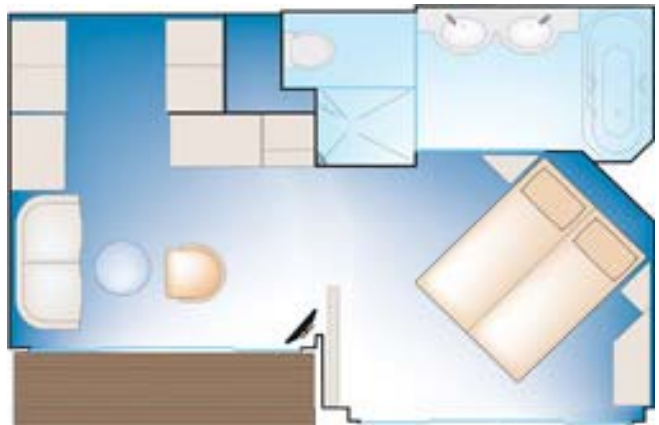
The junior suites offer 194 ft<sup>2</sup> of luxurious comfort for you to feel at home. Two French doors with floor-length glass panes that can open the entire width of the room provide a panoramic view. The entire room features elegant carpet made of highland sheep's wool. All suites have a double bed, two comfortable chairs, a small table, satellite TV, mini bar, telephone, safe and wireless internet connection. Three generous-sized wardrobes with glass doors provide plenty of space for you to store your possessions. The fully glazed marble bathroom has a shower, floor heating, shaving mirror and blowdryer. And every room is equipped with individually adjustable temperature control.

### Deluxe Suite



The deluxe suites feature the same amenities as the junior suites, but with 237 ft<sup>2</sup> have even more space. The diagonally positioned beds enable reclining guests to look directly through the panorama doors. The deluxe suites also have a comfortable seating area with a couch, chairs and table as well as a luxurious marble bathroom with a lavish washing area and large shower.

No where can the Alsace-French flair be stronger felt than in Strasbourg – you will feel as if you have been cast back into the Middle Ages. Marvel at the cathedral that is often called the eighth wonder of the world, or explore the historic tanner and mills quarters – referred to as "La Petite France" – with their magical 500-year-old half-timbered houses.
